Our topic this half term is Rocks, Relics and Rumbles! We will be learning all about natural disasters and exploring the layers of the Earth.

Project Ideas

- Create a model of the layers of the Earth using a range of materials. Label each layer and write a short description about each layer's features.
- Write a poem on the theme of volcanoes. Try to include expanded noun phrases in your poem. For example, scorching hot, exploding lava or jet-black clouds.
- Imagine that you have just experienced an earthquake. Write a short story about what happened. Can you use some of the topic vocabulary from our spellings?
- Make an information poster about Mary Anning, the famous fossil collector. Include images and interesting facts.
