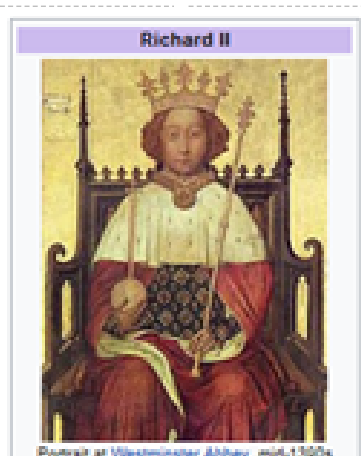

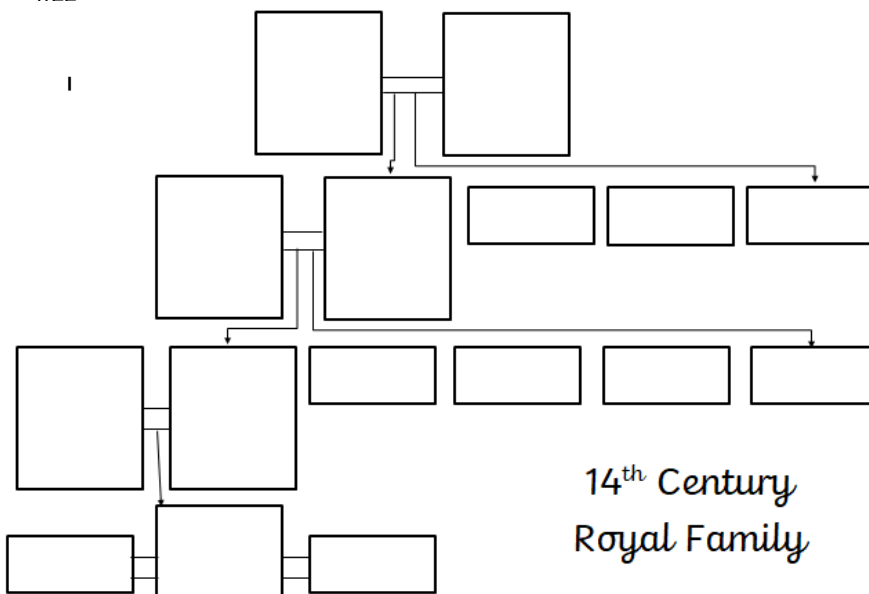
Challenge 1
